Fingerprint Cards AB (FPC) - Policy Statement on DRC Conflict-Free Minerals

FPC is a company with a strong commitment to social responsibility. We believe that as a sustainable company, we need our suppliers and contractors to join us in this commitment.

There has been increased awareness of violence and human rights violations in the mining of Cobalt (Co), Gold (Au), Tantalum (Ta), Tungsten (W) and Tin (Sn) in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries. "DRC Conflict-Free" is defined to mean products that do not contain conflict minerals or their derivatives determined to be directly or indirectly financing or benefiting armed groups in the DRC or adjoining countries (Sudan, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Angola, Congo, and Central African Republic).

FPC shares the deep concern about sources of minerals from these conflict zones and is therefore committed to make its products DRC Conflict-Free and obtain full transparency throughout its supply chain.

FPC has established and implemented procedures to comply with this policy. FPC requires all suppliers to undertake reasonable due diligence within their supply chain to ensure that the minerals are not being sourced from mines in conflict areas.
